



Secretary of the Meeting for an additional charge of £25. N.B. Where a late entry is accepted the organisers may not be in a position to issue the full complement of passes, these may have to be purchased from the circuit. Bank charges for unpaid cheques etc. will be passed on to the competitor by the Club at the rate of £25 per transaction.

Refunds: Full refunds will only be given for any cancellations received by midday on the Tuesday 4th August. No refunds will be given for any cancellations received after this deadline, even if you have an accident in testing in the days leading up to the event. Surplus entries practising in a single class race and failing to qualify, no refund. Nominated reserves who do not get a race will be considered for a refund and the amount will depend on the circumstances. In the unlikely event that the meeting does not happen, BDC reserves the right to retain an appropriate administration fee.

Driver/Vehicle Changes: Any application for change of driver or vehicle must be made in writing to the Secretary of the Meeting, in accordance with MSA Regulations [A 60 (1)], before qualifying and will be permitted at the discretion of the Stewards of the Meeting.

13. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each race, or following the end of the event.

14. Starting positions will be determined by handicap, or practice time for scratch races.

15. Each driver will be given the opportunity to practice as per G.15. Drivers must complete at least 3 practice laps to qualify for a place on the grid. Drivers practicing out of session, or who qualify only through familiarity of the circuit, will be placed on the back of the grid in accordance with G.58.

16. Competitors will be identified by numbers on each side of the car and on the bonnet/front of the car. If competitors have not finished in 6 races prior to this meeting, then they must carry a novice cross at the rear of their car. Please note competition numbers will be available at 'sign-on'.

17. All cars will be checked for sound levels, and must comply with the limits in C(b)23 (C(b)23 exemptions will apply). The Environmental Scrutineer is a Judge of Fact B.81.

18. C(a)58 Entries will be acknowledged on receipt, and any entrant not receiving an acknowledgement within reasonable time of despatching his entry, should contact the Secretary of the Meeting at once (C(a)57 will apply).

The right is reserved to amalgamate or modify competitions within the meeting, should the number and type of entries so warrant.

No substitute of car for that first entered will be permitted in an event containing a handicap element.

19. All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations, and with any special requirements as notified in the SR's, except the following, which are modified: G.40 Competition Numbers need not comply with the dimensions laid down in the Technical Regulations, provided they comply with SR 16 (above), are displayed on a contrasting background, and the clarity of the numbers displayed satisfies the organisers and timekeepers. Cars may be stripped of their wings and lamps (except event 10-the AMOC Pre-War Team Race), if this intention is declared in the entry form.

20. Each competitor is required to have a timing transponder, which they will be required to fit to their car in such a place that it can send an uninterrupted signal vertically downwards to the track, transponders are available to hire on the day, for non BDC members a fee of £25 will apply, if required please indicate this on your entry form.

21. In the case of the abandonment or cancellation of the Meeting the organisers will retain sufficient of the entry fees in order that costs/expenses incurred shall be covered.

REMINDERS and NOTES

By entering this meeting you are also acknowledging that you have first read and understood all of the 2009 MSA General Regulations.

Competitors should be aware that the entry form includes a declaration regarding the use and return of these items.

Spare wheels must be removed from all competing cars for the duration of the event.

The Bentley Drivers Club will organise a Clubmans/National B Race Meeting on Saturday 8th and Sunday 9th August 2009 at Silverstone Circuit, this meeting is inscribed on the NEAFP.

- The meeting will be held under the general regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations and any further written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
- MSA Permit Numbers: Clubmans 53491, National B 53490.
- The event is open to:

- All competitors must hold MSA racing licences of National B or higher grade and Club Membership cards (also championship/series registration cards where applicable). All of these documents will be inspected at signing on. Valid licences and medicals issued by the ASN of a member Country of the EU, Andorra, Iceland, Monaco, Norway, San Marino or Switzerland and equivalent to at least an MSA National A licence will also be accepted at this meeting.
- The circuit is Silverstone National Circuit, Northants and is 1.639 miles in length. The surface is sealed throughout and all racing will be in a clockwise direction.
- Scutineering will start at 0800hrs and practice at 0845hrs. The meeting will open at 1240hrs. Any competitor not signed on by 1100hrs may be excluded. Note that any amendments to times will be notified in final instructions, together with individual signing on, scrutineering and practice session times.

Race 12, note: practice will take place on the Saturday, non Bentleys accepted at the discretion of the race organisers.

Race 9, the organisers will only accept entries which they believe can lap the Silverstone National Circuit in 1m 20s or less in the dry.



AWARDS

8. Awards will be presented as follows: In all races, unless stated otherwise, place awards are dependant on there being:

- In an event: At least 20 starters for 1st, 2nd & 3rd
At least 15 starters for 1st & 2nd
At least 10 starters for 1st
- In a class: At least 6 starters for 1st, 2nd & 3rd
At least 4 starters for 1st & 2nd
At least 2 starters for 1st

All awards are perpetual, unless otherwise stated, and will be distributed at the discretion of the organising Club. Awards for BDC members driving Bentleys to be in accordance with the Challenge Trophy Rules, all to be held for one year.

- EVENTS 1, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 13, 15 & 16 Awards to 1st, 2nd & 3rd.
EVENT 2, 8 & 14 As per Championship Regulations.
EVENTS 5 & 12 A: Vintage, Capacity not exceeding 3 litres

E: Post-War up to 6 litres
F: Post-War over 6 litres
